- 7. The Transfiguration: Matthew 17:1-13 Reveals the divine glory of Jesus, reinforcing the hope of salvation.
- 8. The Triumphal Entry: Matthew 21:1-11 Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, symbolizing the hope of a new kind of King.
- 9. The Crucifixion and Resurrection: Matthew 27-28 Central to Christian hope, showcasing victory over death and sin.
